Terri L. Clinton joined The American Legion in 2003 earning her eligibility for membership through her service in the United States Army during the Panama era as a 98GKP, Electronic Warfare Specialist. She was assigned to the 125th Military Intelligence Battalion at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, separating at the rank of Specialist in 1990.

She attended linguistics school at both the Presidios of San Francisco and Monterey, California, where she tested proficient in reading, speaking, and writing the Korean language. She attended Military Intelligence school at Goodfellow Air Force Base in San Angelo, Texas.

Her involvement in the Legion intensified when her brother-in-law was Killed In Action on August 5, 2005. She has held commander positions at post and district levels, and was elected Department Commander at The American Legion Convention held on June 24, 2017.

She attended National American Legion College in 2012, and served as the President of the Alumni Association in 2021-22.

Before the Department's charter suspension, PDC Clinton served as the Alternate National Executive Committee person, serving an almost two-year term. PDC Clinton represented the Department on the NEC floor at National Headquarters when NEC Tom Florez was unable to attend, and was appointed by the DEC to represent the Department at a Special NEC meeting held in regards to the Department's charter action. PDC Clinton is the 2021-22 Legionnaire of the Year, and the 2023 winner of the Home Front Military Networks Joe Henjum Honoring the Brave award.

PDC Clinton is a graduate of the University of Wisconsin's parliamentary course, is a member of the National Association of Parliamentarians and serves as Post 1's Judge Advocate.


In her professional life, Terri is the Public Affairs Officer for the VA Eastern Colorado Health Care System.
